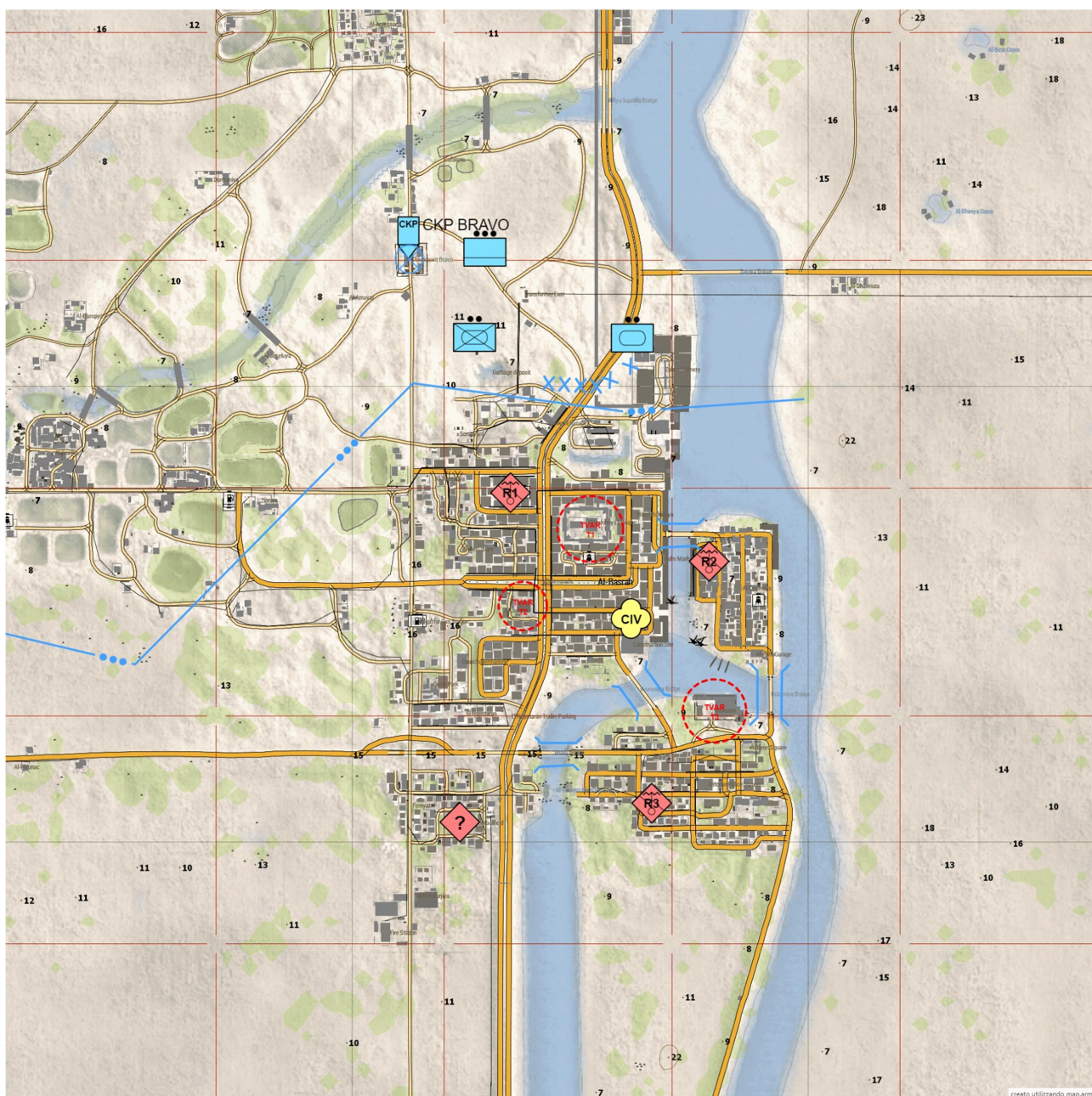
Definizione missione:

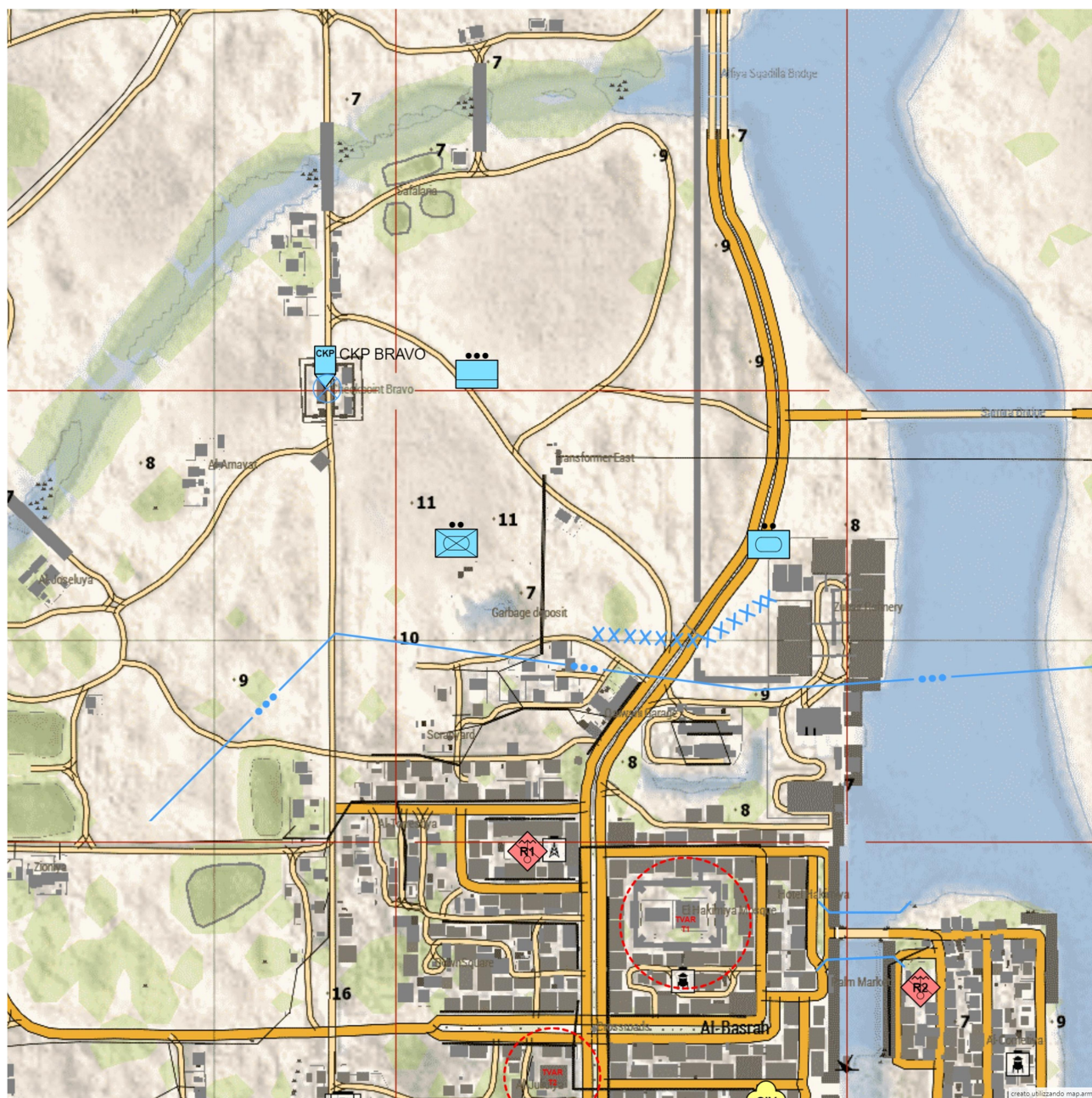
Obbiettivi primari

In zona Sud Ovest della città su marker indicato come "sconosciuto/?" è stata segnalata forte presenza ostile, si ritiene un possibile centro di comando nemico in stretto collegamento con base aerea a Sud; avrete incarico di convogliare tutte le forze nel punto indicato, al termine della messa in sicurezza dell'area Nord. Ogni obbiettivo completato dovrà essere comunicato all'HQ.

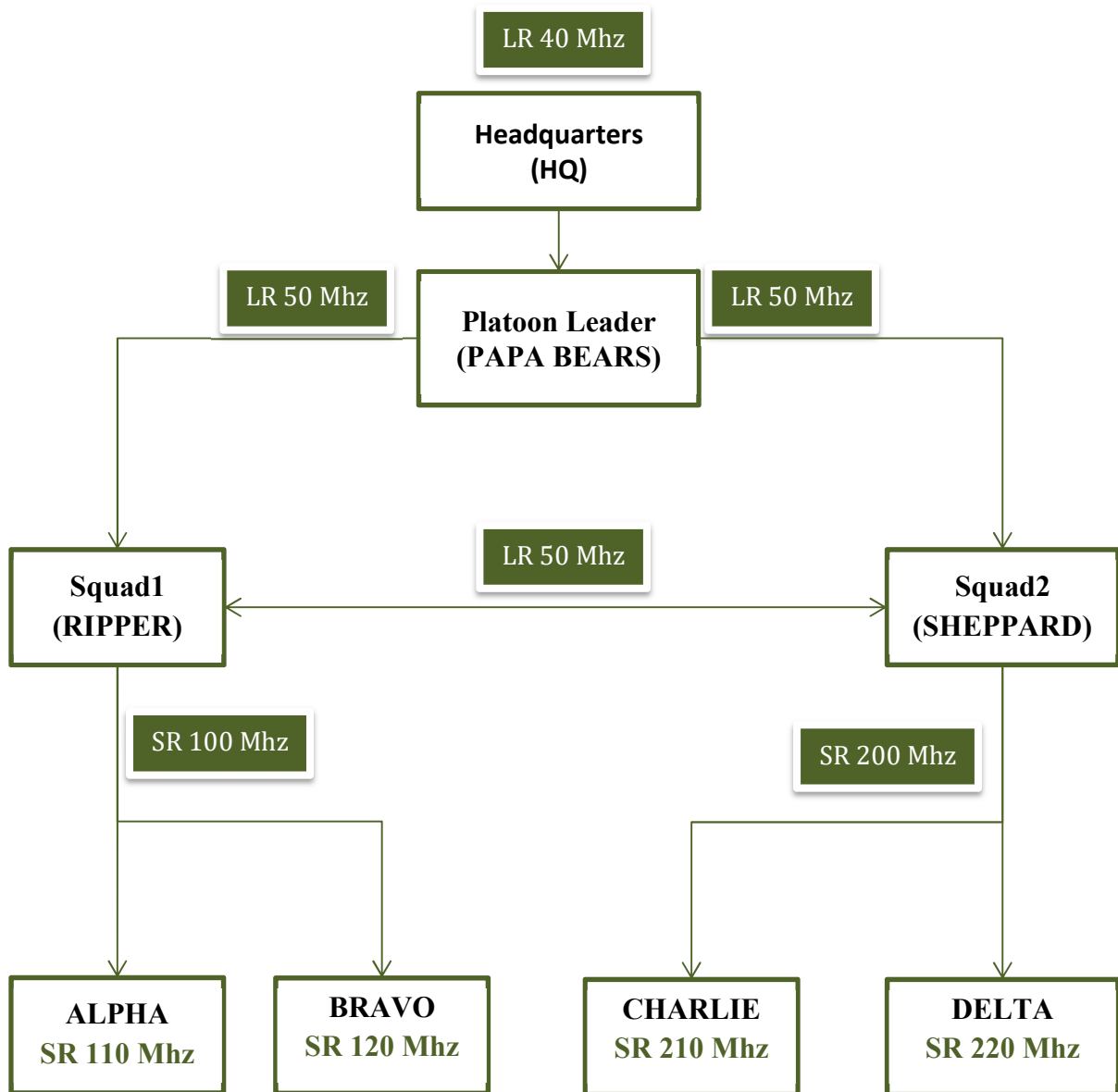
